The Bridgeport Board of Education held their regular meeting on October 14th, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the high school library. All board members were present except Justin Corman who was excused. The consent agenda which included the approval of minutes, financial reports, bills and payroll. All of these passed with a 5-0 vote. There was one action item voted on by the board. Consideration to accept resignation from Trish Schmunk effective at the end of the 2024-2025 school year. This was approved by a 5-0 vote.

- 1. Mr. Simmons reported that the elementary school had a 91% attendance rate for Parent/Teacher Conferences and the Scholastic Book Fair raised \$5,000. The week of October 28th the district will celebrate Red Ribbon Week. Character Counts will be October 25th.
- 2. Mrs. Reynolds reported on the upcoming School Improvement visit that will be January 21st and 22nd. The high school had a 59% attendance rate for Parent/Teacher Conferences.
- 3. Mr. Schlothauer reported on the success of the PreSchool Playground ribbon cutting ceremony held on October 3rd. The end of the 1st quarter is October 18th. Report cards will be sent out by the 24th. Parents will also receive copies of their students' NSCAS scores with the report cards. The district received notification of a 2% increase for the district's insurance rates for the upcoming year. District One Acts will be held at Bridgeport on December 4th. There are 13 students who are planning to attend a choir trip to NY to sing at Carnegie Hall. They are in the process of fundraising to help defray the cost of the trip.


