Consideration to approve second and final reading of boardboard policies #3014 and #4030. Consideration to approve a teaching contract for the 2025-2026 to Anne VanWinkle . These were all approved by a 6-0 vote.



The FAFSA opens December 1st. I have scheduled FAFSA completion days with Andrew Hunzeker on Tuesday, January 7th and Tuesday, January 14th. Please see the attached flyer for information. If you have already completed the FAFSA, remember that you may be selected for verification, you will need to provide additional information to the college that you are attending before the FAFSA is processed. The college may ask for W-2 forms, a tax transcript, or household verification. The college will notify you regarding documentation by posting a message on your TO DO LIST or sending an email to your personal email address.

I have attached the ACT testing dates for the rest of the 2024-2025 school year. Waivers are still available for juniors and seniors. If you are in the Teammates program you also receive one free test per year.

New dual credit classes will begin spring semester. If your child qualified for an ACE scholarship in the fall, they also need to complete a new scholarship application for the spring semester. Please have them see me.


